

NWT-NORTH REGIONAL SKILLS COMPETITION

SCOPE DOCUMENT

29 - HAIRSTYLING – Secondary

(NOTE: Scope may change without notice)

PURPOSE OF THE CHALLENGE

DURATION: 3.5 HOURS

To enable the industry as well as observers to view the level of skills taught within the public, secondary program and to encourage interaction between the various sectors. This relationship will ensure the skills gained by young hairstylists at all levels of training are geared to the demands of the beauty industry.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED

The level of this competition will allow the young stylists to demonstrate their technical skills and creative ability in the following two tests.

1. Classic Evening Updo
2. Female cut/day style

NOTE: No written test will be administered. The theoretical knowledge will be relevant in the performance of the practical.

1. Classic Evening Updo - Duration: 2 hrs

An evening updo will be performed. In no case will the finish be fussy or over sprayed.

- The style is of the competitor's own choice but should follow the international trends.
- The competitors proceed to start on the competition floor with dry hair, combed straight back.
- All tools are allowed, as well as all fixing products.
- Mannequin hair must be a minimum of 8" in length all over the head prior to the start.
- Mannequin draping and makeup are encouraged.

Scoring

International system 30 points

2. Ladies Cut & Style - Duration: 1.5 hrs

A cut and day style will be performed.

- The mannequin from test # 1 goes back to the competition floor shampooed and ready for a new cut.
- The competitors can, if they wish, wet, shape, blow-dry or style the hair during the time allocated for performing their hairstyle.

Scoring

International system 30 points

Criteria

- Balance and form
- Cleanliness of finish
- Originality of design
- Difficulty and overall creativity

NOTE: Competitors will not be judged on color.

EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, SUPPLIES, AND CLOTHING

Provided by the competitor:

- Clean and comfortable work attire as would be worn in a modern hair salon as well as any protective clothing if needed
- Encouraged to provide make-up, jewelry, draping and hair ornamentation for the mannequin

Provided by the committee:

- One competition mannequin: long hair female
- Working tools; water bottle, towels, cape, cutting implements, combs, brushes, clips, blow dryer
- A table and mirror, non-hydraulic chair, and double electrical outlet provided.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Failure to comply with any safety regulations may result in disqualification or removal of competitor from competition.

JUDGING CRITERIA

All judging will be performed according to the IVTO (World Skills) Point System. The contestants with the highest combined points from the two tests will be the winner, the second highest mark will be placed second, and the third highest mark will be third. Demerits may be given for any rule infraction(s).

Any communication between audience and the competitor may be considered coaching and may result in disqualification
