#### **PURPOSE OF THE CHALLENGE**

**DURATION: 6 HOURS**

To highlight the skill and excellence of student's ability in Traditional Sewing techniques.

#### **SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED**

The level of this competition will allow the competitors to demonstrate their technical skills and creative ability in the following project:

- 1 Pair of seal skin slippers with moose hide soles and beaver fur trim.
- Must be completed by hand without the use of a sewing machine.

**Contest Project to be presented at 3:00pm. To Technical Chair for judging.**

#### **Specific Requirements:**

Competitors may not bring any of their own materials. Only those materials provided by the technical committee will be allowed.

**NOTE: Competitors will not be judged on color/pattern of furs**

#### **EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, SUPPLIES, AND CLOTHING**

##### **Provided by the committee:**

- Beaver Pelt
- Moose or other suitable hide
- Sheep or other Fleece
- Sewing Needles (Glover, leather needle, various sizes)
- Thread
- Sinew
- Stitch Ripper
- Thimble
- Scissors
- Utility Blades
- Ruler
- Pens for marking

**\*NOTE: All materials are subject to change based on availability. If a specific material is needed that is not listed above please send an email to the Technical Chair prior to the contest.**
