#### SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED

The level of this competition will allow the competitors to demonstrate their technical skills and creative ability in the following project:

- 1 Pair of lounge pants (flannel or fleece) with elastic waistband
- Small zippered storage pouch

#### Presented at 3:00pm.

#### **Specific Requirements:**

Competitors may not bring any of their own materials. Only those materials provided by the technical committee will be allowed.

Lounge Pants: Adapted pattern from McCall's mens' pyjama pants (faux zipper removed) Choice of S-M-L-XL

Zippered Pouch: Any pencil case size lined zippered pouch approximately 12cm x 20cm. Top Can be pieced using 3-6 different fabrics and any quilting design.
