COMPETITION DESCRIPTION DOCUMENT

29- HAIRSTYLING Secondary & Post Secondary Level

(NOTE: Scope may change without notice)

PURPOSE OF THE CHALLENGE

DURATION: 6 Hours

To assess contestant's skill and expertise in the use modern techniques of cutting, styling and coloring hair.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED

The level of this competition will allow the young stylists to demonstrate their technical skills and creative ability in the following four tests:

- 1) Men's Fashion Haircut with Colour
- 2) Ladies Fashion Updo and Colour

NOTE: Colors may be done beforehand although this is not necessary. No written test will be administered. The theoretical knowledge will be relevant in the performance of the practical tests.

CONTEST DESCRIPTION

TEST 1- Ladies Updo and Colour with Three Wishes

This hairstyle and colour is to reflect a fashion ladies trend. The selection of wishes will be decided by the Experts at the competition C-3. There are three ballot boxes

which represent the client wishes, (cut, colour and texture). One criteria will be selected (ballot) from each box. This selection will take place prior to start of competition. This module must respect industry standards.

COLOUR

- All hair must have a change in colour
- Must respect client (ballot box) wishes (colour)
- Colour must be fashion trend, not funky Avant Garde Note: Competitors must bring a palette of colour choices to allow for any combination chosen from the ballot box.

FINISHED STYLE

- All tools are allowed
- All styling products are allowed with the exception of coloured sprays (including glitter), coloured mousse, coloured gels, coloured markers, crayons etc. cannot be used
- Must respect client (ballot box) wishes.
- Ornamentation must be used
- Hair fillers or padding are not allowed
- No dressing of the mannequin allowed



TEST 2 – MEN’S HAIRCUT AND COLOUR WITH THREE WISHES

RATIONALE

This module calls for Men’s haircut and colour. There are three ballot boxes which represent the client wishes, (cut, colour and texture). One criteria will be selected (ballot) from each box. This selection will take place prior to start of competition. This module must respect industry standards. Hair colour must be changed.

HAIRCUT

- Must respect client (ballot box) wishes
- The look is fashion inspired not OMC
- All cutting techniques and tools are allowed

COLOUR

- Fashion colour not Avant-garde or extreme
- All colouring techniques are allowed to enhance the finished design
- All colour products are allowed to be used in this module with the exception of coloured sprays (including glitter), coloured mousse, coloured gels, coloured markers, crayons etc. cannot be used
- Must respect client (ballot box) wishes



Here are examples of what might be in the Three Wishes draw:

CUT/COLOUR/TEXTURE

- Tattoo
- Colour blocking
- Copper
- Wavy Draw to be done by Jury President.

ESSENTIAL SKILLS

Essential skills are used in nearly every job to varying degrees. They provide a foundation for learning all other skills and enable people to evolve with their jobs and adapt to workplace change. Good Essential Skills will help you understand and remember concepts introduced in technical training. The level of Essential Skills required for most trades is as high or higher that for many office jobs.

Of the nine skills that have been identified and validated as key essential skills for the workplace, this contest involves the following:

EQUIPMENT, TOOLS & SUPPLIES

PROVIDED BY THE COMPETITOR:

- All working tools including hot tools, cutting implements, brushes, combs, etc.
- All styling products.
- Clean and comfortable work attire as would be worn in a modern hair salon as well as any protective clothing if needed.
- Encouraged to provide jewelry, draping and hair ornamentation for the mannequin.
- Your preferred types of styling products.
- Do not provide any makeup on mannequin.

PROVIDED BY THE COMMITTEE:

- Two competition mannequins: 1 long hair female (Oriac Diana, Model #02-222305) 1 male, no beard (Oriac Tony, Model #02-222256)
- Towels, cape
- A table and mirror, non-hydraulic chair, and double electrical outlet provided.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Failure to comply with any safety regulations may result in disqualification or removal of competitor from competition.

POINT BREAKDOWN / 100 TOTAL

All judging will be performed according to the IVTO (World Skills) Point System. The contestants with the highest combined points from the four tests will be the winner, the second highest mark will be placed second, and the third highest mark will be third.

CRITERIA

- Balance and form
- Cleanliness of finish
- Originality of design
- Artistic Impression

Demerits may be given for any rule infraction(s). Any communication between audience and competitor during contest times may be seen as coaching and could warrant demerits.
